Conditions of entry

1. All riders and owners must be members of the EA to compete in official classes.
2. All riders competing in unofficial classes must be either a member of Mallala Show-Jumping Club or the EA.
3. Riders must present in neat and clean attire and horses presented clean and well groomed.
4. All horses nominated for official classes must hold current EA registration and grading cards.
5. All riders and/or guardians for those under 18 years of age, must sign a disclaimer and agree to abide by the rules, regulations and conditions sat down by Mallala Show-Jumping Club.
6. Grading is in accordance with the national grading system.
7. No person, under any circumstances shall lunge, mount or ride a horse at Mallala without being a member of Mallala Show-Jumping Club or the EA and firstly signing a disclaimer. (This includes all grooms and/or support crew). Forms will be available at the secretary's desk or can be sent with entries and current EA membership number must be provided.
8. Lunging is NOT permitted in the practice or warm up arenas.
9. No horse shall be ridden unless entered in an event.
10. The committee reserves the right to refuse entries.
11. The committee reserves the right to swab horses.
12. The organizing committee reserves the right at their discretion to alter and amend any of the above conditions and to modify the program or to cancel an event.
13. NO DOGS ALLOWED.
14. Camping costs \$15 per vehicle per weekend. Temporary yard to be made no bigger than 4m x 4m.
PLEASE NOTE: Only people with horses are permitted to camp.
15. Entries taken on receipt of correct entry and fees until classes are full. Mallala Show-jumping Club members given preference.
16. Membership application will be accepted with entries and relevant discounts applied.
17. A Junior may compete in any of the senior classes but not in the main senior class at this event.
18. If a senior rider competes on a horse that horse cannot then be competed on by a junior rider in a junior class.
19. OBJECTIONS: Objections addressed to the ground jury must be lodged in writing accompanied by a deposit of A\$40.00 within the following time limit -
 - A) Objections against eligibility to be a competitor or horse not later than one hour before the start of competition;
 - B) Objections to an obstacle or to the course or the length or the plan of the course immediately after the inspection of the course and before the start of competition;
 - C) Objections concerning irregularities or incidents during the competition as soon as possible after the end of the competition and not later than half an hour after the announcements of the results;
 - D) The period jurisdiction of the Ground duty extends from one hour before the start of the competition until half an hour after the announcements of the final results for which the Ground duty have been appointed;
 - E) The appeal committee shall deal with appeals against decisions of the Ground Jury with objections referred to it and with all cases of infringement to the FEI regulations and rules for which the Ground Jury are not responsible. All appeals must be in writing accompanied by A\$40.00;
 - F) The federation extends no responsibility for the loss or damage to any exhibit;
 - G) The committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry or to vary conditions to any class, to cancel any event or class without assigning any reason.

20. Facilities:
 - Showers and toilets, full catering, power and water available
 - Please wash horses down in the areas provided.
 - All rubbish, especially bailing twine to be placed in bins.
 - Please leave manure, hay etc. In a pile in front of stables.
